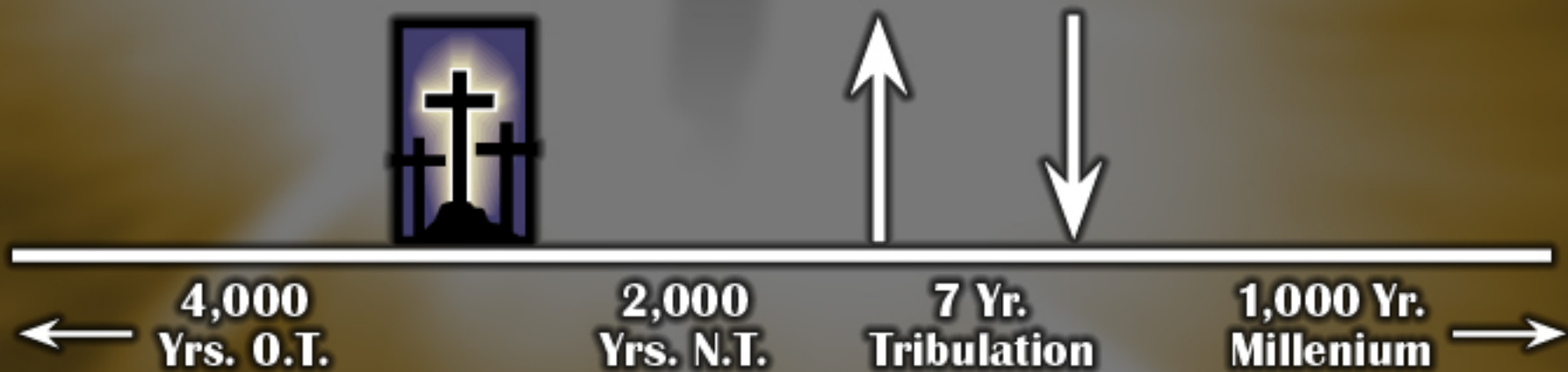

THE RAPTURE

Husbands, love your wives, even as
Christ also loved the church, and gave
himself for it;

Ephesians 5:25

B. New Testament Saints:

After this I looked, and, behold, a door *was* opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard *was* as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will show thee things which must be hereafter.

And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them.;
